MARTIN LEWIS WORK FOR AMNESTY INTERNATIONAL - SINCE 1976...

Martin Lewis is a British-born, US-based producer, writer, marketing strategist, publicist and film/video/audio sales agent. He has worked in those and other capacities for Amnesty International on and off since 1976 - starting at the age of 23! He has worked closely with both the UK section and the US section. He has also liaised on occasion with the International Secretariat. Between 1976-1982 he lived in London. In 1982-1987 his HQ was New York. Since 1988 he has been based in Los Angeles.

Among his signature achievements, he was co-creator - with **Monty Python's John Cleese** - and producer of Amnesty's legendary and influential "Secret Policeman's Ball" series of benefit shows. albums and movies. Cleese credits Lewis with coining the iconic title. Lewis also instigated Amnesty's outreach to musicians - recruiting and producing multiple artists for Amnesty including **Pete Townshend, Sting, Eric Clapton, Jeff Beck, Peter Gabriel, Phil Collins, Donovan, Seal, Paul Rodgers, Bob Geldof** et al.

Lewis worked with Amnesty USA Executive Director Jack Healey in 1987/1988 to conceive Amnesty's groundbreaking "Human Rights Now!" world tour starring **Bruce Springsteen**, **Sting** and **Peter Gabriel** - commemorating the 40th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.

In 2009, Amnesty USA recruited Lewis to renew his active work for the movement. Lewis became deeply involved once again in multiple projects for Amnesty. For "Chimes Of Freedom" - the album of Bob Dylan compositions commemorating Amnesty's 50th anniversary, Lewis was the Contributing Producer – and he personally recruited and produced audio tracks and videos with the following artists: Pete Townshend, Pete Seeger, Billy Bragg, Seal, Jeff Beck, Paul Rodgers, Nils Lofgren, Mick Hucknall (Simply Red), Joe Perry (Aerosmith) and actress/singer Evan Rachel Wood.

In 2012-2013, he instigated and produced the six-disc DVD box set of the "Human Rights Concerts" featuring 12 hours of the major concerts (1986-1998) including U2, Bruce Springsteen, Radiohead, The Police, Peter Gabriel, Lou Reed, Tracy Chapman, Joan Baez, Miles Davis, Bryan Adams, Jackson Browne, Bob Geldof, Wynton Marsalis, Joni Mitchell, Alanis Morissette, Sinead O'Connor, Jimmy Page, Robert Plant and many other artists. He also curated and/or filmed 5 hours of additional contextual footage – including new interviews with Bruce Springsteen, Sting, Bono, Peter Gabriel and others – and Amnesty performances by Green Day, Coldplay, Mumford & Sons, David Byrne, Ozzy Osbourne, Sting, Pete Townshend, Jeff Beck, Pete Seeger, Seal, Joe Perry, Evan Rachel Wood and Bono.

His other work for Amnesty in this period includes instigating, organizing and securing a special iTunes charity single from **Ozzy Osbourne** and producing the music video to promote it (8.8 million views as of March 2025); securing for Amnesty and organizing the all-star US premiere and after-party of the John Lennon bio-pic "Nowhere Boy"; instigating, producing and hosting the New York concert celebrating the 70th anniversary of John Lennon's birth as a benefit for Amnesty. And ensuring Amnesty's presence at the 2010 Kennedy Center Honors by arranging for **Sting** to salute **Bruce Springsteen** (reminding viewers of their long Amnesty connection) and instigating, organizing and cohosting a special intimate Amnesty after-party attended by 25 major stars.

As Producer Emeritus of the 2012 "Secret Policeman's Ball" show at Radio City Music Hall he conceived, co-wrote and produced segments for which he recruited **Monty Python, Robert De Niro**, **Kyra Sedgwick** and **Whoopi Goldberg**. He also acted as worldwide sales agent for the Blu-ray, TV & streaming rights. And he recruited **Helen Mirren, Taylor Hackford** and **Carly Simon** for Al-USA membership drives.
